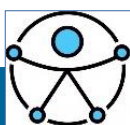
It’s your own decision. Everybody is the risk owner, this is the key.

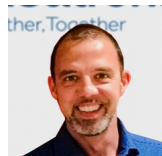

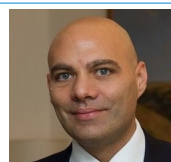

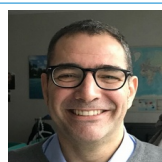
