This research has created a database of benchmarking, which has been automated to present scenarios and provide specific recommendations for PMOs.

The PMO-Certified Practitioner certification, created and maintained by the PMO Global Alliance, has the objective of guaranteeing that the certified professional has a full understanding of the essential concepts of the methodology, the techniques for the definition, application, use of the method, analysis of results and decision making applicable to any industry.

About the Exam:

The PMO-CP Certification is offered in several countries by PMO Global Alliance and its global partner Practical Thinking Group. The exam covers technical aspects related to the PMO VALUE RING methodology and the implementation process. To obtain the certification, the candidate must take an online exam of 40 multiple choice questions, obtaining a minimum score of 75% of correct answers. The candidate has up to 60 minutes to complete the exam. PMO Global Alliance (www.pmoga.com) is an organization that carried out the research and organized the professionals in the world to create the PMO Value Ring methodology. It is based in Brazil and USA and it's not a company but a community of professionals around the PMO issue (education, research, social network). The certification has no expiration and no periodic renewal is required. If there is a significant renewal in the methodology, certified professionals will be notified so that they can be updated at no cost through online material. The cost of the first exam (USD 150) is included in the value of the workshop. If you lose the exam, you have an additional opportunity, it's a ProctorU supervised exam, the exam retake has an additional cost of USD 50, has to be paid to PMOGA and presented after 20 days of the first exam.
